The purpose of the Transition Academy is to provide professional development that will enhance the effectiveness of transition planning in order to ensure successful post-school outcomes for students with disabilities. The Academy will meet four times during the school year with each sessions focusing on a different theme or topic. **Session One                      Staley High School on October 6                      Raytown Education Center on October 7**

- Improving transition documentation in the IEP, including Present Level (Indicator 13) and Form C
- Selecting appropriate informal & formal assessments
- Using assessment results in documentation

**Session Two                      Staley High School on November 10                      Raytown Education Center on November 11**

- Developing self-determination/self-advocacy skills in students
- Addressing transition throughout the primary, middle and high school years
- Increasing parental involvement

**Session Three                      Staley High School on February 9                      Raytown Education Center on February 10**

- Developing employment opportunities for youth with disabilities
- Fostering school-to-work collaboration and/or interagency collaboration

**Session Four                      Staley High School on March 2                      Raytown Education Center on March 3**

- Exploring programs for students aged 18-21 being served by public schools
- Sharing existing programs in the KC area such as school-based enterprises, job shadowing, Job Olympics; these are for any student that is IDEA eligible
