Missouri Assessment Program- Alternative (MAP-A) Training

This training is for Special Education personnel who are **NEW** to the administration of the MAP-A or those that need to be familiar with the MAP-a process. Participants will learn how to select appropriate Alternative Performance Indicators (APIs) to assess student skills, how to develop activities to best evaluate that skill, and how to collect data to document the skill level of the student. Additionally, participants will learn how to write up the activities and the data collected how to complete required forms, how to use the ProFile software, and how to put together all needed documentation. The content will cover requirements for Communication Arts, Mathematics, and Science.

NOTE: This same training for **NEW Examiners** is also being offered other dates in Grandview School District, UMKC PDC at Union Station and North Kansas City School District.

Participants should bring a 3-ring binder and laptop computer if possible. Other helpful tools include highlighters and post-its.
