## MAP-A Testing for Experienced Examiners

Missouri Assessment Program- Alternative (MAP-A) Training

This HALF-DAY training is for Special Education personnel who have been previously trained (EXPERIENCED) on the administration of the MAP-A. The workshop will be a review on choosing appropriate Alternative Performance Indicators (APIs) to assess student skills, developing activities to best evaluate that skill, and collecting data to document the skill level of the student. Additionally, participants will learn how to write up the activities and the data collected; how to use the ProFile software; and how to put together all needed documentation. The content will cover requirements for Communication Arts, Mathematics, and Science.

NOTE: This same training for **EXPERIENCED Examiners** is also being offered in Grandview and North Kansas City school districts.

Participants should bring a 3-ring binder and a laptop computer if possible. Other helpful tools include highlighters, post-its, and some type of tab to mark the various chapters in the MAP-A manual.
