MAP-A Professional Development Scorer Training

To meet the needs of Missouri educators seeking professional development related to alternate assessment, ARC (Assessment Resource Center) has developed a one-day MAP-A scorer training session. The purpose of the session is to allow teachers responsible for administering the MAP-A assessments to students the opportunity to learn the process used to score the MAP-A. Those who attend the training session will gain a deeper understanding of the MAP-A scoring process by:

- Participating in hands-on MAP-A scorer training activities,
- Working with the materials, samples, and processes employed during MAP-A scoring,
- Scoring sample entries with MAP-A scoring managers,
- Learning about inter-rater reliability measures applied to MAP-A scoring, and
- Discussing MAP-a score reports

IMPORTANT: Participants should bring their copy of the *2009-2010 Instructor's Guide and Implementation Manual*. (If an attendee does not have a manual, they should bring a 3-ring binder and they will be given a *Manual* at the training.) Other helpful tools include highlighters & post-its. (If the attendee does not yet have a manual, they should also bring some type of tabs to mark the various chapters in the MAP-A manual.)
