This method of teaching includes practices for students to gain basic knowledge and understanding, provide application and manipulation of the information learned, and challenges students to think critically at the highest and most complex thought processes. Layered Curriculum also provides methods of presenting the information to students with a wide variety of learning styles. This process can be easily modified for Special Education, English Language Learners, and Gifted Students. If you are a teacher that enjoys interaction one-on-one with students and prefers **not to take home work each night**, this is the teaching method for you. This teaching method can incorporate a wide variety of instructional practices and assessment methods you or your school are currently using. This workshop will introduce key concepts, additional resources and ways to utilize technology to support implementation. **Each participant will receive a copy of Dr. Nunley's 2nd Edition of her Layered Curriculum text.**
