This workshop will address Functional Behavior Assessment (FBA) as a process for understanding problem behaviors and the factors that contribute to their occurrence and maintenance. It will also address FBA as a guide for the development of effective, efficient, and relevant behavior interventions. Participants will learn how to use FBAs as part of a problem solving process for identifying the functions of a student's behavior and for developing an effective, meaningful Behavior Intervention Plan (BIP). Topics will include:
