Thirty (30) semester hours in the Foreign Language to be taught, or twenty-seven (27) semester hours plus two (2) or more earned units of high school credit in that language.

Online application packet required for admission to professional semesters. Admission requirements for the professional semesters can be found on the reverse side. Students can have up to 9 credit hours remaining before entering the professional program. **February 1 deadline** for Summer admission.
